- f) Salvation solely by grace through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ for all who repent and believe in Him. Those who believe are born again of the Holy Spirit, receive the gift of eternal life and become the children of God;
- g) The resurrection of the body, the judgment of the world by our Lord Jesus Christ, the everlasting blessedness of the saved and the everlasting and conscious punishment of the lost;
- h) The spiritual unity of all who truly believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and their duty to maintain in all their relationships a standard of life and doctrine that is in conformity with the teachings of God's Holy Word.
